When Korean girl Nico expresses her unhappiness at being so different from her adopted Mommy and Daddy, her mother explains to her that all families are different—and special.

Ryan **One Hundred is a Family**
Groups making up many different kinds of "families" introduce the numbers from one to ten and then by tens to one hundred.

Simon **All Families are Special**
Describes non-traditional family groups, including single-parent families, adoptive families, foster families, divorced families and blended families.

Williams **A Chair for My Mother**
A child, her waitress mother, and her grandmother save dimes to buy a comfortable armchair after all their furniture is lost in a fire.

Displays the many different types of families, even animal families!

A single mother explains to her son that his daddy left soon after he was born. Includes a section with suggestions for answering the question, "Do I have a daddy?"

When his father loses his job, a boy must adjust to his father staying home and taking care of him while his mother works.

PC 306.874 LEV **Finding the Right Spot**
A young girl living with her foster parent describes the emotional ups and downs of being separated from her mother and living in unfamiliar surroundings.

PC 306.8747 LEV **Do You Sing Twinkle?**
A boy's parents help him adjust to his new stepfamily when his mother remarries after a divorce. Includes note to parents.
