**Chew, R. Earthstar Magic**  
Ellen and Ben meet a friendly witch who reveals the magic power of the earthstar to them.

**Cooper, S. The Magician's Boy**  
A boy who works for a magician meets familiar fairy tale characters when he is transported to the Land of Story in search of a missing puppet.

**Coville, B. Dragon of Doom**  
Life in the village of Pigbone is boring until an aspiring magician and his talking toad come to town and ask Edward to help them slay the Dragon of Doom.

**Cowell, C. How to Train Your Dragon**  
Chronicles the adventures and misadventures of Hiccup Horrendous Haddock the Third as he tries to pass the important initiation test of his Viking clan, the Tribe of the Hairy Hooligans, by catching and training a dragon.

**Cussler, C. The Adventures of Vin Fiz**  
Ten-year-old twins Casey and Lacey fly an enchanted, antique airplane, named the "Vin Fiz," across the United States and have several daring adventures along the way. Includes historical notes on the real "Vin Fiz," the name of the airplane that made the first transcontinental flight in 1911.

**Dahl, R. James and the Giant Peach**  
Wonderful adventures abound when James escapes from his fearful aunts by rolling away inside a giant peach.

**DiTerlizzi, T. Spiderwick Chronicles:  
The Field Guide**  
When the Grace children go to stay at their Great Aunt Lucinda's worn Victorian house, they discover a field guide to fairies and other creatures and begin to have some unusual experiences.

**Duey, K.                      Moonsilver**

Heart, a foundling who was discovered five years earlier wrapped in a unicorn-embroidered blanket, finds a pregnant white mare in the woods and struggles to keep her and her colt safe and well.

**Gannett, R.                      Elmer and the Dragon**

On their way home, Elmer and a flying dragon land on an unusual island and help some canaries uncover a buried treasure.

**Greenburg, D.                      The Onts**

Ten-year-old orphan twins Wally and Cheyenne Shluffmuffins have a hard time at Cincinnati's Jolly Days orphanage, but things get much worse when the Mandible sisters offer to share their home in the Dripping Fang Forest.

**McAllister, A.                      Digory the Dragon Slayer**

Digory, a gentle boy who likes to spend time alone in the forest and make up songs to sing, accidentally becomes a knight and reluctantly sets off to rescue damsels in distress, slay dragons, and marry a princess.

**McMullan, K.H.                      The New Kid at School**

Wiglaf is off to Dragon Slayers' Academy and in for a first day of school he will never forget.

**Moore, L.                      I'll Meet You at the Cucumbers**

Adam and Junius, two country mice, go for a visit to the city, where Adam despairs when his dear friend admits he might like to stay.

**Murphy, J.                      The Worst Witch Saves the Day**

Havoc ensues as Mildred, hoping to find a cure for her klutziness, starts her third year at Miss Cackle's Academy for Witches, where she soon has a curling-iron catastrophe and gets on the bad side of a new teacher.

**Pinkwater, D.                      Lizard Music**

When left to take care of himself, a young boy becomes involved with a community of intelligent lizards who tell him of a little known invasion from outer space.

**Potter, E.                      Olivia Kidney**

Twelve-year-old Olivia explores her new apartment building and finds a psychic, talking lizards, a shrunken ex-pirate, an exiled princess, ghosts, and other unusual characters.

**Rodda, E.                      The Charm Bracelet**

When Jessies searches for her ill grandmother's missing charm bracelet, she is led into a magical world and finds she has a reason and right to be there.

**Scieszka, J.                      Knights of the Kitchen Table**

Joe receives a magic book for his birthday present from his uncle. Joe, Fred and Sam are transported to a time when evil knights, fire-breathing dragons and vile-smelling giants roamed the land. (Time Warp Trio Series)

**Steig, W.                      Abel's Island**

Castaway on an uninhabited island, Abel, a very civilized mouse, finds his resourcefulness and endurance tested to the limit as he struggles to survive and return to his home.

**Vande Velde, V.                      Wizard at Work**

A young wizard, who runs a school to teach wizards, looks forward to a quiet summer off but is drawn into adventures with princesses, unicorns, and ghosts instead.
