Ahlberg, A.     **Skeleton Crew**

Three skeletons have a good time on their sailing vacation, until their boat is boarded by pirates.

Andreae, G.    **Captain Flinn and the Pirate Dinosaurs**

When Flinn enters the classroom art closet for supplies, his imagination sends him on a high-seas adventure filled with pirates, dinosaurs, mystery, and swordfights.

Bunting, E.     **Pirate Boy**

As Colin imagines himself in a series of adventures beginning with joining a pirate crew, his mother assures him that she will always be there to help if he needs her.

Crimi, C.       **Henry and the Crazy Chicken Pirates**

When the Buccaneer Bunnies receive a note from an unknown enemy, Henry researches and writes a book called "Henry's Plan for Impending Danger from the Unknown Enemy who wrote the scary note."

Demas, C.      **Pirates go to School**

A rhyming tale of pirates who go to school accompanied by their parrots, learn arithmetic and letters, and want to hear sea stories at story time.

Duddle, J.      **The Pirate Cruncher**

A mysterious old pirate lures a group of rowdy sailors to an island with buried treasure, but there is a surprise awaiting them when they get there.

Faulkner, M.   **The Pirate Meets the Queen**

When the son of notorious Irish pirate queen Granny O'Malley is captured by the English, Granny tries to meet with Queen Elizabeth I to negotiate for his freedom.

Fox, C.           **Pirate PiggyWiggy**

PiggyWiggy imagines what it would be like if he and his friends were swashbuckling pirates.

Funke, C.       **Pirate Girl**

Ferocious Captain Firebeard and his ruthless pirates meet their match when they kidnap a small, feisty, smart girl named Molly.

Gibbons, G.    **Pirates Robbers of the High Seas**

Describes the lives of pirates, the ships they sailed, and the type of treasure they stole.

Harris, P.       **The Night Pirates**

Despite the fact that he is the only boy, Tom convinces the band of rough, tough little girl pirates to let him join in their adventures.

Jarman, J.      **Class Three at Sea**
